

LOCAL PUBLIC SAFETY MEASURES  
MAY 20, 2008, PRIMARY ELECTION



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**Clatsop County**

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*Local Option Tax (Measure 4-127)*

Taxing District: Lewis & Clark Rural Fire Protection District  
Term: Five-Year  
Purpose: Fund full-time salary and benefits for Fire Chief and provide funding toward replacement of fire equipment and apparatus.  
Cost: \$0.90 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

**Election Results:**  **Pass (51%)**  **Fail**

*\*Double Majority Requirement Met: Yes (56%)*

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**Deschutes County**

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*Local Option Tax (Measure 9-55)*

Taxing District: Deschutes County 9-1-1 District  
Term: Five-Year  
Purpose: Maintain existing 9-1-1 services, continue emergency preparedness notification network, update records systems and fund space for additional dispatchers.  
Cost: \$0.23 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

**Election Results:**  **Pass (59%)**  **Fail**

*\*Double Majority Requirement Met: Yes (53%)*

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**Douglas County**

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*Local Option Levy (Measure 10-87)*

Taxing District: North Douglas County Fire & EMS  
Term: Five-Year  
Purpose: Replace an ambulance, outdated equipment and hire one full-time paramedic/firefighter.  
Cost: \$0.99 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

**Election Results:**  **Pass (61%)**  **Fail**

*\*Double Majority Requirement Met: Yes (61%)*

## Jefferson County

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### *District Formation/Permanent Tax Rate (Measure 16-49)*

Taxing District: Three Rivers Rural Fire Protection District  
Term: Permanent  
Purpose: Form fire district to provide fire protection, prevention, emergency medical and rescue services (passage would allow absorption of Three Rivers Volunteer Fire Department).  
Cost: \$1.65 per \$1,000 of assessed value.  
Election Results:  **Pass (70%)**       **Fail**  
*\*Double Majority Requirement Met: Yes (81%)*

## Klamath County

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### *Local Option Levy (Measure 18-67)*

Taxing District: Klamath County Emergency Communications District  
Term: Five-Year  
Purpose: Hire additional dispatchers and enhance dispatcher and other personnel training and fund moving costs to seismic safe building with improved radio and computer systems.  
Cost: \$0.47 per \$1,000 of assessed value.  
Election Results:  **Pass**       **Fail (52%)**  
*\*Double Majority Requirement Met: Yes (59%)*

### *General Obligation Bond (Measure 18-68)*

Taxing District: City of Klamath Falls  
Term: Thirty-One Year  
Purpose: Remodel, construct, furnish, acquire personal property and equip new police station.  
Cost: \$4 million bond; unknown \$ per \$1,000 of assessed value.  
Election Results:  **Pass (50.29%)**       **Fail**  
*\*Double Majority Requirement Met: Yes (59%)*

## Lane County

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### *Local Option Levy (Measure 20-136)*

Taxing District: Western Lane Ambulance District  
Term: Four-Year  
Purpose: Maintain current levels of service.  
Cost: \$0.25 per \$1,000 of assessed value.  
Election Results:  **Pass (63%)**       **Fail**  
*\*Double Majority Requirement Met: Yes (60%)*

## Tillamook County

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### *Local Option Levy (Measure 29-113)*

Taxing District: City of Bay City  
Term: Five-Year  
Purpose: Provide full fire protection services, maintain fire protection equipment, and provide training.  
Cost: \$0.47 per \$1,000 of assessed value.  
Election Results:  **Pass (58%)**       **Fail**

*\*Double Majority Requirement Met: Yes (67%)*

## Washington County

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### *Local Option Tax (Measure 34-148)*

Taxing District: Washington County Enhanced Sheriff's Patrol District  
Term: Five-Year  
Purpose: Current local option levy of \$0.49 per \$1,000 of assessed value expires June 30, 2008. Measure would fund current level of service.  
Cost: \$0.63 per \$1,000 of assessed value.  
Election Results:  **Pass (64%)**       **Fail**

*\*Double Majority Requirement Met: Yes (55%)*
