Deschutes County

General Obligation Bond (Measure 9-56)

Taxing District: Redmond School District
Term: Twenty-Six Year
Purpose: Construct, equip, and furnish new high and elementary school;
finance capital repairs; and improve student safety.
Cost: \$1.55 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

Election Results: **Pass (59%)** **Fail**

**Double Majority Requirement Met: Yes (62%)*

Gilliam County

Local Option Levy (Measure 11-18)

Taxing District: Condon School District
Term: Five-Year
Purpose: Maintain ability to offer vocational agricultural classes and the
national FFA Organization at the high school.
Cost: \$1.15 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

Election Results: **Pass (66%)** **Fail**

**Double Majority Requirement Met: Yes (78%)*

Hood River County

General Obligation Bond (Measure 14-29)

Taxing District: Hood River School District
Term: Fifteen-Year
Purpose: Fund upgrades, renovations, energy efficiencies and remodeling of
all schools.
Cost: \$1.47 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

Election Results: **Pass (60%)** **Fail**

**Double Majority Requirement Met: Yes (69%)*

Local Option Tax (Measure 14-30)

Taxing District: Hood River School District
Term: Five-Year
Purpose: Maintain current programs, class size and full school year.
Cost: \$1.25 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

Election Results: **Pass (58%)** **Fail**

**Double Majority Requirement Met: Yes (69%)*

Klamath County

General Obligation Bond (Measure 18-66)

Taxing District: Klamath Community College
Term: Ten-Year
Purpose: Finance capital construction for expanded college facilities; retire existing college debt used to purchase the existing campus; and pay bond issuance costs for new college classrooms and science and computer labs, fund additional instructional programs and expand college classes for high school students.
Cost: \$1.15 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

Election Results: Pass Fail (52%)

**Double Majority Requirement Met: Yes (59%)*

Sherman County

Local Option Tax (Measure 28-34)

Taxing District: Sherman County School District
Term: Five-Year
Purpose: Replace existing expiring levy to maintain current levels of service.
Cost: \$0.21 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

Election Results: Pass Fail (51%)

**Double Majority Requirement Met: Yes (65%)*

Wallowa County

Local Option Tax (Measure 32-30)

Taxing District: Wallowa School District
Term: Five-Year
Purpose: Fund extracurricular activities and athletics.
Cost: \$1.03 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

Election Results: Pass Fail (57%)

**Double Majority Requirement Met: Yes (69%)*
