MAY 19, 2026 SPECIAL ELECTION**

**Baker County**

---

*Amend Ordinance (Measure 01-137)*

Taxing District: Baker County  
Purpose: Revise government structure by creating a county administrator position appointed by, and directed by, the county board, requiring annual selection of board chair, and making all commissioner positions equal in time commitment, duties, and compensation.

**Election Results:**     Pass (25%)             Fail (75%)

**Benton County**

---

*Local Option Levy Renewal (Measure 02-142)*

Taxing District: Brownly-Marshall Road District  
Term: Five Year  
Purpose: Maintain road maintenance and repairs.  
Cost: \$0.45 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Total estimated tax collection \$25,335.

**Election Results:**     Pass (71%)             Fail (29%)

*Charter Amendment – Model Charter (Measure 02-143)*

Taxing District: City of Corvallis  
Purpose: Amend the home rule charter to align with the League of Oregon Cities model charter.

**Election Results:**     Pass (82%)             Fail (18%)

*Charter Amendment – Remove Provisions (Measure 02-144)*

Taxing District: City of Corvallis  
Purpose: Amend the home rule charter to remove certain provisions that are not in the League of Oregon Cities model charter.

**Election Results:**     Pass (80%)             Fail (20%)

*Charter Amendment – Exercise of Powers (Measure 02-145)*

Taxing District: City of Corvallis  
Purpose: Amend the home rule charter related to adoption of resolutions, ordinances, orders, etc., to align with the League of Oregon Cities model charter.

**Election Results:**     Pass (81%)             Fail (19%)

*Charter Amendment – Vacancies, Quorum, Qualifications (Measure 02-146)*

Taxing District: City of Corvallis  
Purpose: Amend the home rule charter related to vacancies in office, quorum requirements, and qualifications for office to align with the League of Oregon Cities model charter.  
**Election Results:**  Pass (81%)  Fail (19%)

*Psilocybin Ordinance (Measure 02-147)*

Taxing District: City of Philomath  
Purpose: Prohibit psilocybin-related businesses and psilocybin product manufacturing.  
**Election Results:**  Pass (49.57%)  Fail (50.43%) \*diff of 15 votes

*Annexation (Measure 02-148)*

Taxing District: City of Philomath  
Purpose: Support annexation of single island tax lot on Pioneer Street into the city.  
**Election Results:**  Pass (70%)  Fail (30%)

*Annexation (Measure 02-149)*

Taxing District: City of Philomath  
Purpose: Support annexation of single island tax lot on 7<sup>th</sup> Street into the city.  
**Election Results:**  Pass (70%)  Fail (30%)

*Annexation (Measure 02-150)*

Taxing District: City of Philomath  
Purpose: Support annexation of single island right-of-way on 7<sup>th</sup> Street into the city.  
**Election Results:**  Pass (73%)  Fail (27%)

*Annexation (Measure 02-151)*

Taxing District: City of Philomath  
Purpose: Support annexation of single island tax lot on 9<sup>th</sup> Street into the city.  
**Election Results:**  Pass (69%)  Fail (31%)

*Annexation (Measure 02-152)*

Taxing District: City of Philomath  
Purpose: Support annexation of single island tax lot on 17<sup>th</sup> Street into the city.  
**Election Results:**  Pass (70%)  Fail (30%)

*Annexation (Measure 02-153)*

Taxing District: City of Philomath  
Purpose: Support annexation of single island tax lot of 0.61 acres on 19<sup>th</sup> Street into the city.

**Election Results:**  **Pass (69%)**  **Fail (31%)**

*Annexation (Measure 02-154)*

Taxing District: City of Philomath  
Purpose: Support annexation of single island tax lot of 2.91 acres on 19<sup>th</sup> Street into the city.

**Election Results:**  **Pass (68%)**  **Fail (32%)**

*Local Option Levy Renewal (Measure 02-156)*

Taxing District: Chinook Drive Road District  
Term: Five Year  
Purpose: Maintain maintenance and repair of roads.  
Cost: \$0.85 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Total estimated tax collection \$166,803.

**Election Results:**  **Pass (83%)**  **Fail (17%)**

**Clackamas County**

---

*Charter Amendment – Vacancies, Quorum, Qualifications (Measure 03-632)*

Taxing District: City of Wilsonville  
Purpose: Amend charter to require voter approval for creation of, or substantial changes to, urban renewal plans, specified public notice information.

**Election Results:**  **Pass (58%)**  **Fail (42%)**

*Local Option Levy (Measure 03-637)*

Taxing District: City of Rivergrove  
Term: Five Year  
Purpose: Maintain general operations, including planning, engineering, legal support, and other administrative functions.  
Cost: \$0.50 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Estimated tax collection \$315,000.

**Election Results:**  **Pass (36%)**  **Fail (64%)**

**Clatsop County**

---

*Charter Amendment – Model Charter (Measure 04-240)*

Taxing District: City of Warrenton  
Purpose: Amend the home rule charter to align with the League of Oregon Cities model charter.

**Election Results:**  **Pass (64%)**  **Fail (36%)**

*Advisory Vote – Fluoridation (04-241)*

Taxing District: City of Warrenton  
Purpose: Determine support for city to continue add fluoride to drinking water.

**Election Results:**  Pass (61%)  Fail (39%)

**Columbia County**

---

*Local Option Fee (Measure 05-311)*

Taxing District: City of St. Helens  
Term: Ten Year  
Purpose: Add fee to utility accounts based on equivalent dwelling units to fund general fund staffing, programs, and services.  
Cost: \$24 per month adjusted annually based on the CPI-U.

**Election Results:**  Pass (14%)  Fail (86%)

**Coos County**

---

*Charter Amendments (Measure 06-229)*

Taxing District: City of North Bend  
Purpose: Amend the city charter to revise mayor's term of office, process for council rules, process for filling council vacancies and removing councilors from office.

**Election Results:**  Pass (37%)  Fail (63%)

---

**Douglas County**

---

*Local Option Fee (Measure 10-211)*

Taxing District: Riddle Cemetery Maintenance District  
Term: Five Year  
Purpose: Maintain and operate cemetery.  
Cost: \$0.05 per \$1,000 of assessed value.

**Election Results:**  Pass (65%)  Fail (35%)

*Charter Amendment (Measure 10-212)*

Taxing District: City of Myrtle Creek  
Purpose: Amend charter to require city administrator to become and remain a resident within the city zip code within six months of employment.

**Election Results:**  Pass (55%)  Fail (45%)

## Harney County

---

### *Advisory Vote - Lodging Tax (Measure 13-027)*

Taxing District: Harney County  
Purpose: Impose a transient lodging tax on short-term stays in hotels, motels, inns, bed and breakfasts, RV parks, campgrounds, vacation rentals, and similar lodging located within unincorporated areas; authorizes process for extending to facilities within cities.  
Cost: 6 percent  
Election Results:  Pass (38%)  Fail (62%)

## Jackson County

---

### *Local Option Levy Renewal (Measure 15-240)*

Taxing District: Rogue Valley Transportation District  
Term: Five Year  
Purpose: Maintain general operations.  
Cost: \$0.13 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Estimated total tax collection \$15.42 million.  
Election Results:  Pass (63%)  Fail (37%)

## Jefferson County

---

### *Local Option Levy Renewal (Measure 16-116)*

Taxing District: Camp Sherman Road District  
Term: Five Year  
Purpose: Maintain snow plowing, basic road maintenance, and road safety.  
Cost: \$0.20 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Total estimated tax collection \$142,874.  
Election Results:  Pass (80%)  Fail (20%)

## Josephine County

---

### *Local Option Levy Renewal (Measure 17-127)*

Taxing District: Josephine County  
Term: Five Year  
Purpose: Maintain animal shelter and animal control.  
Cost: \$0.16 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Total estimated tax collection \$8.9 million.  
Election Results:  Pass (53%)  Fail (47%)

## Klamath County

---

### *Local Option Levy Renewal (Measure 18-144)*

Taxing District: Antelope Meadows Special Road District  
Term: Five Year  
Purpose: Fund road maintenance.  
Cost: \$0.78 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Total estimated tax collection \$14,000.  
**Election Results:**  **Pass (59%)**  **Fail (41%)**

## Lane County

---

### *Advisory Vote – Rights for Watershed and Clean Water (Measure 20-373)*

Taxing District: Lane County  
Purpose: Initiative petition to establish rights concerning watersheds and water, beyond existing water regulations, free from harmful contamination; creates private enforcement rights and damages.  
**Election Results:**  **Pass (38%)**  **Fail (62%)**

### *Charter Amendment – Gender-Specific Pronouns (Measure 20-376)*

Taxing District: City of Eugene  
Purpose: Amend charter to remove gender-specific pronouns.  
**Election Results:**  **Pass (64%)**  **Fail (36%)**

### *Charter Amendment – Residency Requirements (Measure 20-377)*

Taxing District: City of Eugene  
Purpose: Amend charter to remove the requirement that department heads reside within the city limits.  
**Election Results:**  **Pass (43%)**  **Fail (57%)**

### *Local Option Levy Renewal (Measure 20-380)*

Taxing District: Lane County  
Term: Five Year  
Purpose: Maintain 4-H operations and capital and OSU Extension Service programs.  
Cost: \$0.05 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Total estimated tax collection \$12.81 million.  
**Election Results:**  **Pass (50.32%)**  **Fail (49.68%)**

## Lincoln County

---

### *Charter Amendments (Measure 21-238)*

Taxing District: City of Toledo  
Purpose: Amend the city charter to clarify official roles, correct errors, and allow approval of ordinances by title.  
**Election Results:**  Pass (69%)  Fail (31%)

### *Local Option Levy (Measure 21-240)*

Taxing District: Makai Road District  
Term: Five Year  
Purpose: Fund pavement and storm drain system restoration and rebuilding street shoulders.  
Cost: \$0.85 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Total estimated tax collection \$39,000 to \$41,000 annually.  
**Election Results:**  Pass (59%)  Fail (41%)

## Linn County

---

### *Charter Amendments (Measure 22-215)*

Taxing District: City of Sweet Home  
Purpose: Amend the city charter to modernize language, update procedures for elected office vacancies, emergency ordinances, council/mayor disciplinary actions, council ethics and conflict of interest, and voting requirements for vacancies, land use decisions, and utility rates.  
**Election Results:**  Pass (56%)  Fail (44%)

## Marion County

---

### *Charter Amendment (Measure 24-519)*

Taxing District: City of Stayton  
Purpose: Amend charter to require popular vote for annexations of more than three acres, make mayor a voting member of the council, modernize process of filing council vacancies, add city manager duties, and clarify municipal judge authorities.  
**Election Results:**  Pass (53%)  Fail (47%)

### *Advisory Vote – Event Center Projects (24-522)*

Taxing District: City of Woodburn  
Purpose: Determine support for lowering speed limits in residential areas.  
**Election Results:**  Pass (36%)  Fail (64%)

## Umatilla County

---

### *Charter Amendment (Measure 30-173)*

Taxing District: City of Milton-Freewater  
Purpose: Amend charter to require city manager to live within the city within the period set by the council, update indebtedness limits to those allowed by state law, require convening a charter review committee at least every ten years, and modernize the severability provisions.  
Election Results:  Pass (74%)  Fail (26%)

## Union County

---

### *Local Option Levy Renewal (Measure 31-123)*

Taxing District: Union County  
Term: Five Year  
Purpose: Fund noxious weed control.  
Cost: \$0.12 per \$1,000 of assessed value. Total estimated tax collection \$1.55 million.  
Election Results:  Pass (60%)  Fail (40%)

## Wallowa County

---

### *Ordinance Repeal – Meetings to Promote State Borders (Measure 32-011)*

Taxing District: Wallowa County  
Purpose: Determine whether county board should meet twice each year to discuss relocating state borders to become part of Idaho.  
Election Results:  Pass (61%)  Fail (39%)
